Dayspring Christian Academy seeks to develop the servant character of Christ within the students by including a community service requirement for graduation. The objective is that young people interact within their communities; therefore, activities that are designed specifically to impact the church community only, such as teaching Sunday school classes, helping in the nursery, leading worship in church, setting up chairs for the service, etc., while greatly appreciated and needful, are not included in the number of service hours required. Church-related outreaches into the community or world at large (e.g., missions trips and vacation Bible school), however, are eligible. In addition, though school-related volunteering is considered a normal part of school life so is not typically included toward the service hours requirement, Dayspring will accept up to 8 afterschool volunteer hours within the school outreach events such as PCD, Thanksgiving Exposed, and/or the Remember America Speaker Series. Students may begin accumulating these service hours the summer after their 8th grade graduation and ***must submit this completed form by the end of the third quarter of their senior year.
